




Vision and Mission:

Program Objectives:

Admission Eligibility:

- According to the UGC rules, applicants must have at least GPA 2.5 in both SSC and HSC (or equivalent). If there is any GPA 2.00 in SSC/HSC (or equivalent), then the total sum of total GPA must be 6.00.
- For O level & A level, at least for 5 subjects in O level and 2 subjects in A level, the applicants must have GPA 4.00 or B grade in 4 subjects & GPA 3.5 / C grade on the other 3 subjects.
- For freedom fighters' children, the total GPA may be considered as 5.00 for each applicant.

Admission Requirements:

- Application form
- Two copies of recent passport-sized photographs.
- Photocopies of all board certificates, mark-sheets and testimonial.
- Photocopy of NID/birth certificate/passport

Admission Test:

Admission test will have two parts in 100 marks;

Part 1: Contains multiple-choice questions covering English language & literature and general knowledge.

Part 2: Contains written English on essay or paragraph.

Note: Students with GPA of at least 5.00 or a combined score of at least 1100 on the SAT Reasoning Test will directly be called for an interview without admission test.
